

CALEDONIA SPORTSMAN'S CLUB WINTER LEAGUE RULES for 2011

1. You must be a club member to shoot in the league.
2. All league and membership fees must be paid in full before you shoot your 1st registered round. **NO ONE CAN SIGN UP FOR THE LEAGUE AFTER THE 4TH WEEK.**
3. Before you shoot, you will need to purchase a punch card for all events and it must be presented to the cashier when you sign up to shoot each round. You must also inform as to which week you are shooting. You must have 4 registered lines shot by the end of the 4th week so that we can classify everyone. **Note:** After the first 4 weeks, the normal rules will apply. (See League rules) No penalties will be assessed during the first 4 weeks. If you do not get 4 lines in by the end of the 4th week, there will be an **8-bird** penalty. The normal penalty system will be in effect for the rest of the league (see rule #5 & #8). Also at time of sign up we need to know if you are a Sub Junior, Junior, Lady, Novice or Vet.
4. You must complete the league for the scores to count for individual and team trophies. Even if one person fails to complete the league this will stop a team from qualifying for the 1st or 2nd place. If a person fails to complete the league, they **ARE NOT** allowed to use the remaining rounds for practice after the league is complete. If a person fails to complete the league they will not qualify to shoot in the Calcutta.
5. Sign up for one line at a time. You **CANNOT** shoot more than four rounds in a week (after the 4th week). A maximum limit of 5 shooters on any line when there are registered.
6. It is the shooter's responsibility to mark the score sheet for a registered round. You must mark a **red "R"** beside your name. This must be done **BEFORE** shooting. Other than a gun malfunction, after you shoot the 1st bird, your score stands. If there is a machine breakdown, you will be moved to another field to complete the round. If fields are full, you will be the next line out.
7. If you mark a round as **"R"** and decide to shoot a practice round, cross off the **"R"** and have it initialed by the person in charge at the counter. Otherwise the score will be counted as a registered round. **THIS MUST BE DONE BEFORE SHOOTING THE ROUND.**
8. You can only be 2 weeks behind. If you are more than this, you will be penalized 1 target for each week behind. No scores will be held back. All lines must be completed at the end of the 12th week of league. **ANY** exception to this rule **MUST** have **WRITTEN** permission from the Shooting Committee.
9. Shot size: 7-1/2, 8 and 9 only.
10. Broken birds are shot again regardless of hit or miss. Proof doubles will be shot on Skeet.
11. Classes are based on the firsts 4 weeks of league or known ability. You can only drop 1 class **PER** year. If a person has not shot for 2 or more years, they will re-establish a new classification.
12. **Juniors** are anyone 15 years thru 17 years, **Sub-Juniors** are anyone 14 years and younger and **Vets** are anyone 60 years or older, at start of league.
13. **Novice** class is for a new shooter who has not competed in past leagues, this is class C and D only after you are classified.
14. Pullers are in control of the fields at all times and their decisions are final. **ANY** protest must be submitted in writing to the Shooting Committee within 24 hours.
15. The Shooting Committee will handle any decisions regarding the shooting rules.
16. **EYE** and **EAR** protection must be used at all times. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**
17. If there is a discrepancy with the birds during a registered round, have the line stopped and the machines repaired.
18. NSSA and ATA rules apply only if said instance is not already covered by above rules.
